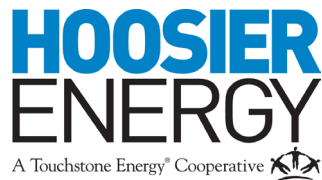

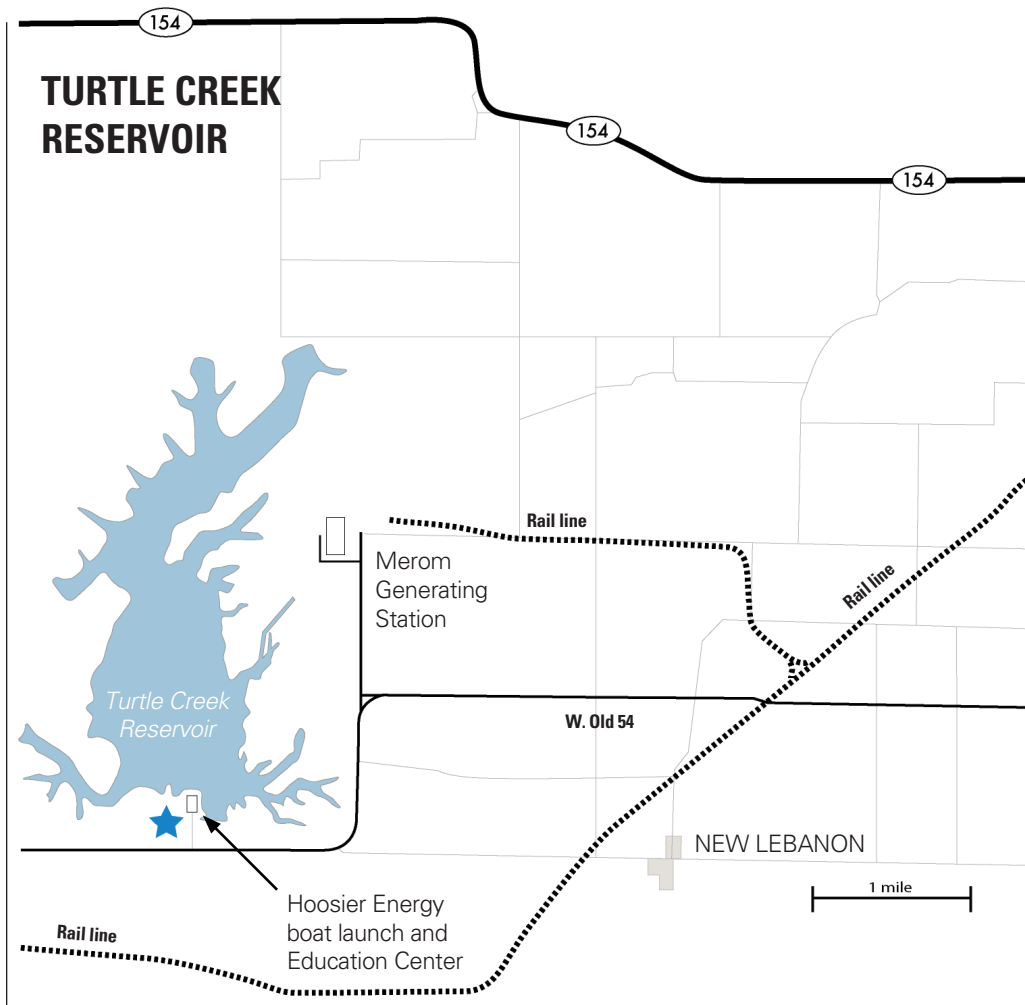
Angling for a good time?
